Board member positions are, also, available. Please consider taking a position. Our chapter can only continue to grow with new officers and new ideas.

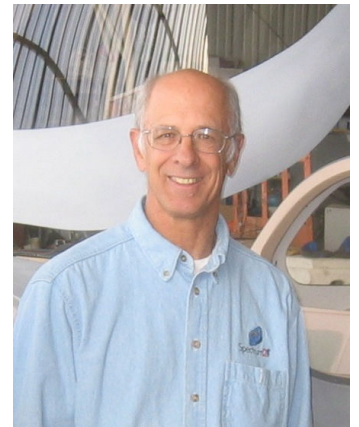
